1. 1814. DOVER MILEAGE MARK. On entire letter (part missing). Reverse a red CDS. At from '8' erased and replaced by '11' the correct fee for 170 to 230 miles. Dover – Norwich is 179 miles. **£60**
2. ROWLAND HILL. A HAND WRITTEN AND SIGNED LETTER. Written from his home in Hampstead and dated 17<sup>th</sup> April. Written the 'Professor Rogers' (Thorold Rogers and Liberal Politician). Neatly folded twice. Hills signature is lovely and clear. A SUPERB CENTREPIECE TO THE COLLECTION. **£750**



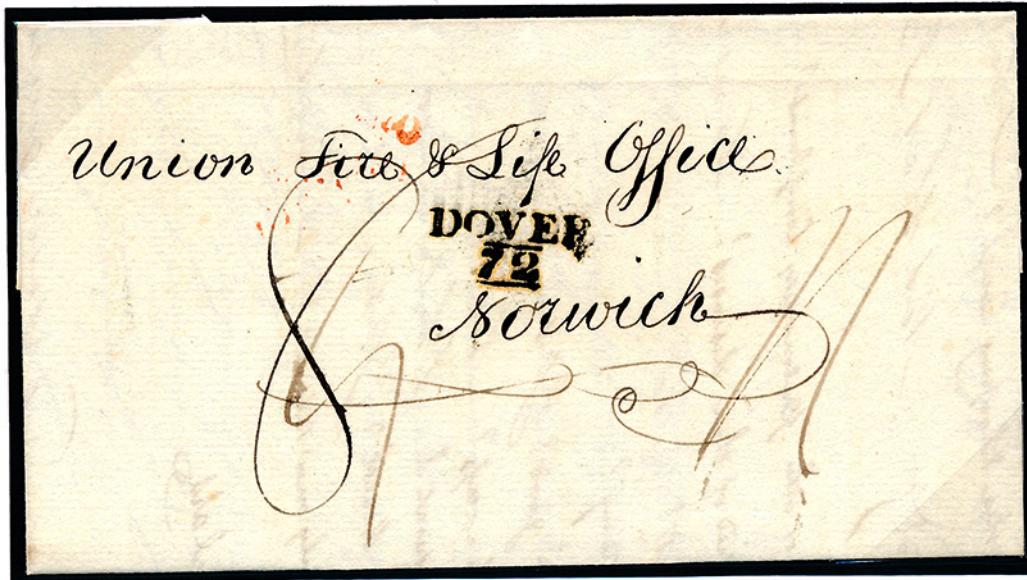


3. Plate 1a showing very slight signs of plate wear. A wonderful adhesive lettered RJ. Outstanding well cut margins and a light full and upright Maltese cross in red. **£385**
4. 1d black plate 2. Lettered GI with perfectly cut and balanced margins and a crisp complete Maltese cross in black. **£325**
5. 1d black plate 2 on wrapper from Appleby to Kirkby Lonsdale. The adhesive lettered PK and tied by a red Maltese cross. Excellent margins cut good – LARGE. Reverse flap with two APPLEBY CDSs for NOV 11 & 12 1840. Fine and uncreased. **£375**
6. PLATE 3. 1d grey black. A very fine shade. Lettered EA with margins cut good – ENORMOUS and a pin sharp and featherlight Maltese cross in orange – red. EXCEPTIONAL STAMP. **£425**
7. 1d intense black plate 4. A MAGNIFICENT SINGLE lettered TL with margins cut good – large – ENORMOUS. A VIBRANT BRIGHT ORANGE – RED Maltese cross. A FABULOUS SHADE and the last adhesive in the sheet. **£425**
8. 1d intense black plate 4. Lettered TK. Perfectly balanced margins and a vivid orange – red Maltese cross. **£325**
9. 1d black plate 4. A beautiful adhesive lettered PD. Choice full margins and a wonderfully crisp Maltese cross in bright red. **£325**
10. 1d very grey black plate 6. With choice, square cut margins and lettered QL with a crisp lightly placed Maltese cross in black. **£350**
11. PLATE SIX. AN UNRIVALLED ADHESIVE. Lettered OA. HUGE – ENORMOUS MARGIS and a complete and upright Maltese cross in deep red. A breath taking single. **£750**
12. A BLUE MALTESE CROSS – A GREAT RARITY ON A 1d BLACK. Plate 8 and lettered NK with irregular margins cut good – enormous. Just barely touching design in part at base. Clear at upper left. The cross is a perfect blue shade. RARELY IF EVER SEEN. Very striking. **£925**

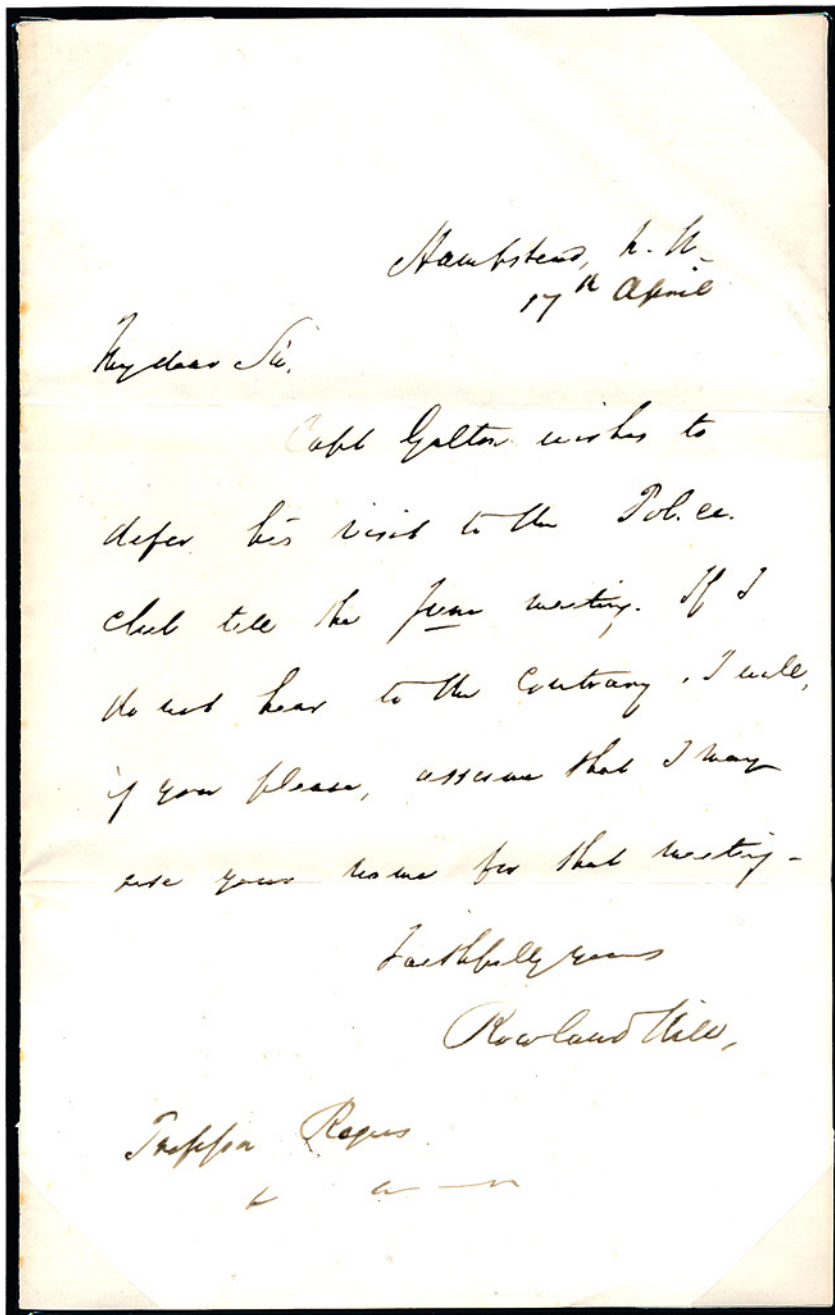
THE ROYAL MAIL WILSON HYDE 1899

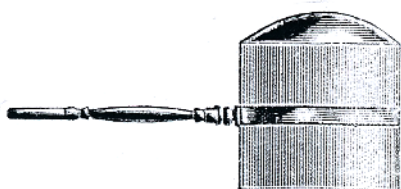




Odd Complaints
